



Notice

This is to inform that the Foreign Ministry has authorized Sri Lankans **who are willing to undergo paid quarantine to return to Sri Lanka by weekly cargo flights operated by SriLankan Airlines.**

All the passengers who wish to return by the weekly cargo flights operated by SriLankan Airlines are subjected to the following.

- I. The person has to undergo PCR tests within 96 hours or rapid antigen test within 48 hours of his/her departure. The passenger needs to carry a negative PCR test report (in English) throughout his/her journey.
- II. After arriving in Sri Lanka the person will be subject to a mandatory PCR test at the airport. **The passenger has to bear the cost.**
- III. If the person is tested negative for COVID-19, he/she has to stay **at a paid quarantine centre, recommended by the Sri Lanka Army during the period of quarantine.** (14 days from time of check in at the hotel)
- IV. **Expenses with regard to the transport from the Airport to the recommended hotel need to be settled by the passenger.**
- V. **Between 10th-12th days the person has to undergo the second PCR test in Sri Lanka.**
- VI. If the person is tested positive for COVID-19 he/she will be admitted to a government hospital in consultation with the regional epidemiologists.
- VII. Prior to leaving the quarantine centre, the area Medical Officer of Health (MOH) would recommend him/her for home quarantine for a period of 14 days.
