Current Initiatives




1. Development of fully pledged marina

Proposed to develop a marina at Kapparathota (Weligama) with multipurpose harbour and to be completed through below phases.

- Construction of breakwater
- Construction of Marina and other facilities

Activities completed

- Completed Pre- Feasibility, Feasibility Study and Detailed design to construct the Breakwater







2. Development of a Regulatory Framework

Completed the development of a regulatory framework for the Boat Building industry covering the following areas;

- Registration/regulations for all boat categories manufactured in Sri Lanka (other than fishing boats)
- Registration/regulations for leisure craft operations in the country and for visiting yachts/crafts to Sri Lanka
 - Regulations/standardizations for imports of boats to Sri Lanka

The new regulation is implementing by the Merchant Shipping Secretariat under the Merchant Shipping Act.

Galle Marina



- Located in the East-West maritime trade route with a world-renowned transshipment hub, the island nation boasts all the elements for a fully-fledged marina hub. It has scenic beaches with year-round sunshine, ancient ports in Galle (South of Sri Lanka).
- Currently, the Galle Harbour provides yachting facilities and is a popular port of call for yachts sailing past. More than 300 trade vessels are also said to sail ten nautical miles away.

The mini marina in Mirissa fisheries harbour is used for mooring a boat. Sailors, crossing the Indian Ocean or on a trip around the world, can use our marina on a daily, weekly or monthly basis.


